



"He was a great, father, husband and a great brother of the Mystic Seven. He leaves behind his wife Jennifer and 2 kid's, Hailey and Willis. He was a former child pastor and was always praying for all of us. Wayne was always smiling and now he is an angel riding beside his brother's. The family has set up a GoFundME account "Support for the Wilson Family" (from Coconut Creek); any help will be appreciated. The Mystic Seven will also be holding a benefit at a later date."

At press time funeral arrangements have not been made, however if you are reading this online Tuesday, Jan 3rd, you will receive an email from me (if you are on my email list) about the funeral and benefit as soon as I find out. 



### Ummm... Good Cookin' with Cookie

### Low Fat Chicken Cashew

1/2 cup brown rice

- 3 medium sized chicken breasts, cut into inch size pieces
- 1 cup diced celery
- 1 red bell pepper, chopped into bite size pieces
- 1 green bell pepper, chopped into bite size pieces
- 1 can sliced water chestnuts, rinsed & drained
- 1 cup water
- 2 tbsp gluten free soy sauce
- 1 tbsp rice vinegar
- 1 tbsp minced garlic
- ½ tbsp minced ginger
- ½ tsp cumin, ¼ tsp salt, ½ tsp pepper
- 1 cup cashews & green onions for garnish

Preheat oven to 375F and spray a casserole dish with nonstick cooking spray. Place brown rice on the bottom of the casserole dish then layer celery and bell pepper. Place chicken on top of veggies. RICE GOES IN THE CASSEROLE DISH UNCOOKED WITH CHICKEN & VEGGIES

In a separate bowl, mix seasonings with soy sauce, rice vinegar, garlic & ginger then add mixture to casserole. Layer water chestnuts on top.

Bake 45 minutes at 375F uncovered. Remove from oven, add cashews & bake another 10 minutes.


Add green onions serve. Yum and low fat.





# **Woo's New View's**

Well another New Year begins on our journey through life! I wish you all the very best in 2017!


As you may know, my dearest friend, and one of the original WOTR moto-journalists, "Modest Mike", was in a terrible accident November 25th. He was T-boned on his motorcycle by a pick-up truck and lost his left leg below the knee. He also had compound fractures of his left femur and right upper arm, as well as broken ribs, internal injuries and too many other problems to mention. Needless to say he's in really bad shape. Mike has been in a medically induced coma for a month but thankfully he's on the mend. Oh so slowly, but at this stage we will take thousands

of an inch of improvement over falling into another crisis. Please pray for him and a small donation to his GOFUNDME page will go a long way in his recovery! Just type in "Modest Mike" or "Mike Mathews" and 2 funds will pop up. They both go to Mike so choose either fund. You can also read updates and additional information I haven't mentioned. Just think of all the cash we blow on crap and how just a few bucks could help a really stand up Brother. He's a REAL BIKER and NOT A POSER! A guy that only has a motorcycle (no other vehicle) and rides it every day, everywhere, in any weather, to go shopping, and take care of his business. He has more two wheeled miles on his ass backing out of his driveway than most of the people you see on bikes have going forward! God Bless Him and YOU for helping my dear friend, Modest Mike.

Last month I started telling you how to go about getting started on refinishing your bike (or any machine for that matter). Now there are several ways to strip paint, rust and any other contaminants from metal. There's sanding, good for small areas, and my favorite... chemical strippers (paint remover), for complete removal of all paint, rust and also the best way to prep metal to mechanically hold primers, paints or whatever you're going to cover it with. There are several things to consider when opting to sand blast. On heavy metal (frames, cylinders, handlebars, and things of that nature) the really big blasters are great. NEVER have them use it on tanks and sheet metal fenders, and NEVER on PLASTIC pieces. The big blasters create HEAT... and lots of it. I found that out years ago from a friend of mine who owned a company called Atomic Sandblasting. He did buildings, bridges, and large structures. He had a huge truck with a very big engine driven compressor. The engine was separate from the engine that moved the truck. I brought him an old Harley frame with the old big fenders. I think it was in the 40's, I can't exactly remember. He stripped the entire frame in about 10 to 14 minutes and it looked beautiful! Then he did the tanks and fenders and... Oh shit! Big mistake!! The paint and rust were completely gone but the problem was, as I later found out when I was fitting the pieces to the frame before primering, the heat from the sand blasting had warped the crap out of the fenders. I learned to sandblast fenders and other sheet metal it's best to use a cabinet type blaster with lower air pressure and a fine abrasive.

Another thing you will find, especially here in Florida where we have so much humidity, is that bare metal will start to rust up almost immediately. Also, just touching it will rust it very quickly as well. The trick for that is bring a bottle of OSPHO or RUST CRUSHER (those are brand names) with you and immediately wipe down all the parts with it.





It's just diluted Phosphoric acid which turns the top of the metal into iron phosphate. It will not rust unless you break the surface. The metal will turn a grayish color, or if you put too much on a black residue. If it turns black the easiest way to get it off is just to put some OSPHO on a rag and scrub the black off. The solution on the rag will dissolve the black and leave the metal gray. It also makes a great base to put your primer on.

Enough for now, hopefully... more next month.

**H**appy New Years folks! There is always something awesome about ushering in a new year with high expectations.

I am in San Diego, CA as I write this article, after riding the Long Distance Ride (LDR) from Jacksonville, FL, to San Diego, CA, in 50 hrs or less. This Coast-to-Coast haul-ass run is an Iron Butt Association run called the 50cc. They also have the 100cc for the LDR NUTS where they turn

around and head back with no or little sleep.

The run started about 3:40 am from Jax beach where I collected some sea water and sand. I was escorted by two LDR mama's... Susan and Cathy, who are St. Augustine locals who rode with Eric Sprague and I to Tallahassee. Eric was my one-way riding partner since he decided to sleep 3-hours in CA... then turned back to FL. I stayed behind to explore CA since I have never been here before.

I was announcing the run on FaceBook for about two weeks, asking for LDR friends to accompany me partial route. I had some Hoka Hey brothers west of Tallahassee that rode with Eric and I up to Louisiana's I-10/I-16 interchange. I was surprised to see my good friend Tim LaBlanc of Louisiana pulling up next to me on his Sling Shot on I-10. You may remember Tim from my former article because he is the one that planted the bug in my brain to ride from Ushuaia, Argentina, up the Pan American Highway to Prodhoe Bay, Alaska. Tim's "Claim to Fame" is that he was the stunt pilot for all the James Bond movies from 1998-2003. He pulled up with a friend of his who was riding a H-D Road King. The support was overwhelming and needed since rain would soon come and cold temps dropped to 22 degrees west of San Antonio.



I had a film crew following me in a mini van (no... not Freddy) taking pics and documenting the run. I want to thank Barry Callaway, of the Wings of Gold MC, and Flash, from the American Legion Riders Post 180 for sharing driving the van coast to coast. It was equally hard on them... fighting traffic

& lack of sleep to make sure Ken Barr, my excellent videographer/photographer/graphic designer guy got the best shots. (So far the film looks great!)

The plan is to make a short film that I will record on DVD to promote LDR and encourage folks to get out of their comfort zone to challenge themselves to accomplish a LDR feat. There are many different LDR runs like the Hoka Hey Motorcycle Challenge that is American motorcycle oriented. The Iron Butt Association (IBF) is a world wide LDR group with hundreds of self documenting runs one can ride, with their basic run - 1,000 miles in 24 hours or less. The IBA certified my Pan American run as the first Harley-Davidson to make that run. My name was added to their list, along with BMW's and other Jap bikes. In addition there are many regional and local folks that organize LDR runs throughout the U.S.

As I write this article I am monitoring the Weather channel that says the temps will drop and when I get to Louisiana I will enjoy heavy rain as a extra special bonus... It's O.K. because there is no such thing as a bad day to ride, only bad riding gear. I have heated gear as well as my high end waterproof riding suit. But... my suit must have shrunk since it feels a little tighter. (It can't possibly be all the cake, pies, cookies or

pastries I've been eating these four weeks since Thanksgiving...) But not to worry because one of my top New Year's resolutions is to get back in shape to film more LDR films.

So I'll be riding back to Jacksonville as soon as I finish this article. I should be back to Fort Lauderdale



either late Monday evening or before dinner on Tuesday. I'll be finishing this article for the February issue... if there is a February issue that is.

I am saying this because ad revenue is no longer covering the expense of publishing this magazine. Many national and regional magazines are in the same position with well over 1000 out of business the last few years. And going digital only has never worked for bikers. Most advertisers will not pay much to place their ad in an online biker mag so there is no real financial incentive to publish online. For the majority of us we don't have time to go online every time we want to know what's happening around town, or what band is playing where, or who has oil change specials. Plus we do like to look at the photos of our friends, sexy gals, ex-wives and motorcycles. With a printed magazine we just stick it in our back pocket or tourpack or saddlebag, or in the bathroom and it's there when we need it. The few local magazines that have tried digital lasted less than a few months... if that.

For the past 4 or 5 months MM has taken money out of his pocket to keep WOTR going in the hopes that after the presidential election new advertisers (and former advertisers as well) would be in a better position financially to run an ad for their shop or bar... but as of this January issue the new ads didn't quite make up for the advertisers that recently dropped out.



I want to request that you help support this magazine financially as I do. MM won't continue to publish WOTR in the red after this issue so it's up to us in the biker community to help keep this awesome magazine that informs us all of the runs, parties, annuals, and all the local businesses we rely on. Please support us by taking out an ad if you have a shop, a bar, a band, a product you sell online or Ebay, or just make a \$12 donation which comes out to \$1 a month, or if you have been reading WOTR for 17 years, comes out to less than 6¢ an issue for 207 issues. If you can donate \$25 or more you will become a VIP and

receive a nice patch to sew on your vest showing you support us. With over 25,000 worldwide monthly readers, if everyone donated just \$1 in the next 3 weeks, there would be enough money to publish WOTR for the next 6 months even if more advertisers drop out, which we hope doesn't happen. It's up to you; if you want to keep Wheels on the Road in print you need to make a donation before January 16th because that's when the decision must be made to start the February issue or not.







I was able to attend two races this month, one being held at Palm Beach International Raceway and one being held at Bradenton Motorsports Park. The race held at Palm Beach was the annual Citrus Nationals. This race has been held in Palm Beach every November for at least the past 25 years and is the track's largest event of the year. Although the race may have had downsides over the past years, there was a great turnout this year.

The race was highlighted by Danny O'Day and his ATI sponsored wheelstander, along with Bob Motz and his jet semi-truck. These are two of the

legends of the sport of drag racing and have been around for many years. They always put on a hell of a show and never cease to amaze. Danny O'Day owns the world's fastest wheelstander running at speeds of over 150 mph in the quarter-mile on the rear wheels! Bob Motz is one of the pioneers of jet powered trucks and has been doing this longer than must of have been alive. The stands were full and the racing was phenomenal. Many people came out and it was good to see the stands packed!

The second race was the Snowbirds, held at Bradenton Motorsports Park. This is one of the biggest races in Florida for both racers and spectators alike! There was a Pro Mod shootout with 200+ mph cars, along with Bob Motz and his Jet Truck. The Little Red Wagon wheelstander was there, this is one of the first wheelstanders in the history of drag racing. The Larsen Motorsports team was in the house with all their jet dragsters. There wasn't an empty seat in the house and the staging lanes were packed!
