Ummm... Good Cookin' with Cookie

DEE'S HOME MADE GELETO

1 cup sugar

4 large egg yolks

1 tsp pure vanilla extract

11/4 cups heavy cream, lightly whipped.

1/4 cup glazed cherries

1/4 cup dried apricots

1/4 cup dried pineapple

½ cup chopped pistachios

6 oz fresh raspberries

Extra dried fruit and pistachio for garnish

Bring the sugar and 1/4 cup water to a boil in a small saucepan over high heat,

boil in a small saucepan over high heat, stirring to dissolve the sugar. Boil for 5 minutes, until thick and syrupy.

Beat the egg yolks with a hand-held electric mixer, slowly adding the hot syrup, until the mixture is cooled, thick, and pale. Fold in the whipped cream and vanilla. Transfer one third of the mixture to another bowl and stir in the cherries, apricots, pineapple, and pistachios. Cover and refrigerate.

Purèe the raspberries in a blender. Rub through a fine sieve to remove the seeds and stir into the plain cream mixture. Pour into shallow metal baking dish and freeze, stirring occasionally with a large metal spoon, about 4 hours until partially set. Freeze a metal bowl with about 3½ cups capacity until very cold. Spread the raspberry cream in the bottom and up the sides of the bowl, leaving a cavity in the



center. Fill with the chilled fruit mixture. Cover and freeze at least 8 hours, until firm. Dip the bowl into warm water for a few seconds and then invert onto a serving plate and remove the bowl. Decorate with dried fruits and pistachio nuts, cut into wedges and serve immediately.

This story is about Memorial Day and to honor those who made the ultimate sacrifice for our country. I am going to start with a story about an event that happened over one hundred years ago...



Woo's New View's

Hi Peeps!

Another beautiful South Florida month is upon us! How lucky we are to be living here. I love everything about South Florida EXCEPT the traffic and the third world a-holes who clog up our roads. You know who I mean... the ones' who haven't a clue what Road Courtesy means. Who doesn't realize their cars have turn signals as standard equipment. Who doesn't think of stepping on their brakes and slowing down instead of just blowing their horn at you. The real pieces of shit who have to text while they are driving, especially the brain dead playing with their phones when the light turns green and they just sit there hypnotized till you have to blow your horn to wake

them up! But by then, a lot of times, the light has turned red again and you have to wait for the green again! As John Wayne said "You can't fix stupid!!"

The old EME girder frontend I have for my Honda SOHC 750 (836cc) chopper only has four inches the legs, as it was originally designed for either a free wheeling spool hub or the old Halcraft mini drum or mini disc brake. Both, by the way, were only good for looks and to hold you from rolling backward on a hill. As far as stopping goes...

USELESS at any speeds above a crawl. Not only am I building the bike to look cool, I also want it to be a great road bike too.

I went looking for a front wheel that not only looked good and would fit inside the legs, would also have a front brake that looked great, but more

importantly... would stop great too!

I remembered back to the mid seventies when I built a radical volks powered trike. The girder I had for it was a narrow bitch too. Back then I took a 750 Honda hub and narrowed it and put dual disc's on it. I figured if I did it then, why couldn't I do it now? A friend of mine got me a Sportster front hub and I sectioned 1-3/4 inches out of the center. I wound up with a 3" wide hub that used a stock Harley disc. Someone had originally suggested that I widen the front end, but it was so beautiful narrow that I decided that sectioning the hub was the only way to go to keep the look I wanted.

So now I have to get the hub powder coated (metallic silver with large metallic flakes), put the new bearings in, as the old ones were set up to use a 1" axle and the front end was built for a 3/4 " axle. As soon as I have the bearings installed in the hub it's going to be laced to a 21"x1.85 40 spoke rim. The spokes are polished stainless and the rim chromed. My friend Woody is going to make the spacers and the axle then the front end will almost be done. The bike is being done old school. I remember old school because it was New when I started in bikes. No Rat or grunge on it. All paint, polished chrome and everything pretty! She will look like a time capsule just puked her out of the 70's!!



I have the frame in my living room and every night I mold a little more of it. Nowadays it's the only way I can do it. It's really boring shit, almost as exciting as watching a glacier race down a valley! It's amazing how many steps are involved in project like this. The big payoff is when it's all finished and you hit the button, and like Dr.

Frankenstein, you see your "Monster" come to life! For me it's more exciting than sex!! You young guys will know what I mean if you're lucky enough to reach my age! LOL Anyway, you all have a Great month, be Happy, Safe and ride sober!
